Once you have collected your bags:

- Transfer via the Air Train (\$5.00 ticket purchase on site) to the Jamaica Center Station.
- Take the E Train (blue line) towards Manhattan to the 42<sup>nd</sup> Street-Port Authority Station. (Approximately 1 hour transfer)
- Walk three blocks south and one block west.

2:30 PM Arrive at your hotel, the **Hampton Inn Times Square South**; check-in to the

hotel. (You may need to store bags if rooms are not ready.)

(West 39<sup>th</sup> Street between 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> Avenues)
